The GAST Network was founded on November 16, 2009 as a platform to systematically develop German - ASEAN Science and Technology cooperation. At the same time, the network sought to specifically enhance synergies & networking among institutions/groups in Southeast Asia that had preexisting ties with Germany. Since early 2011, in conjunction with the restructuring of the GAST Network, the focus of GAST has been redirected towards industrial and commercial cooperation to support the transfer of technologies from Germany to Southeast Asia.
